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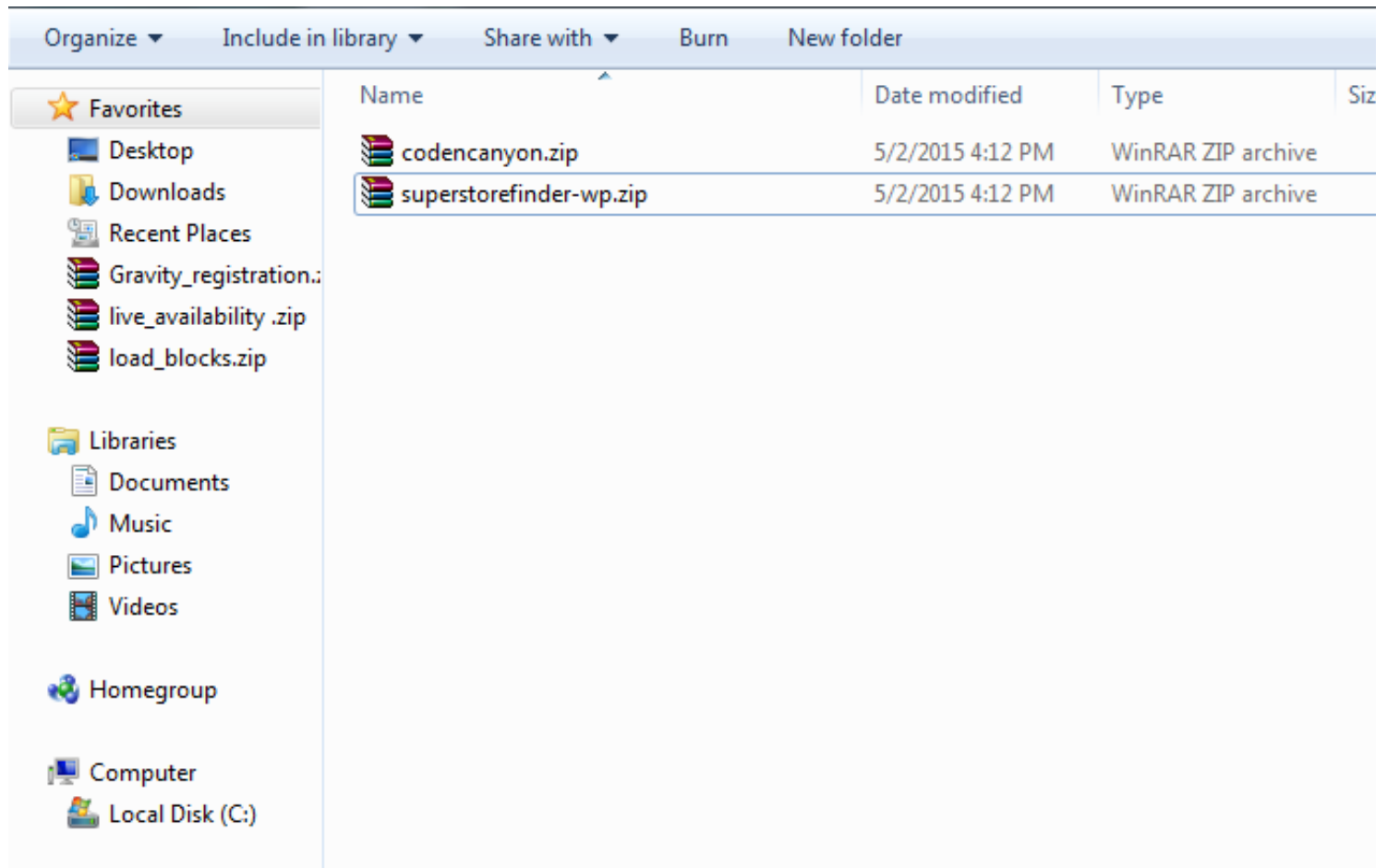

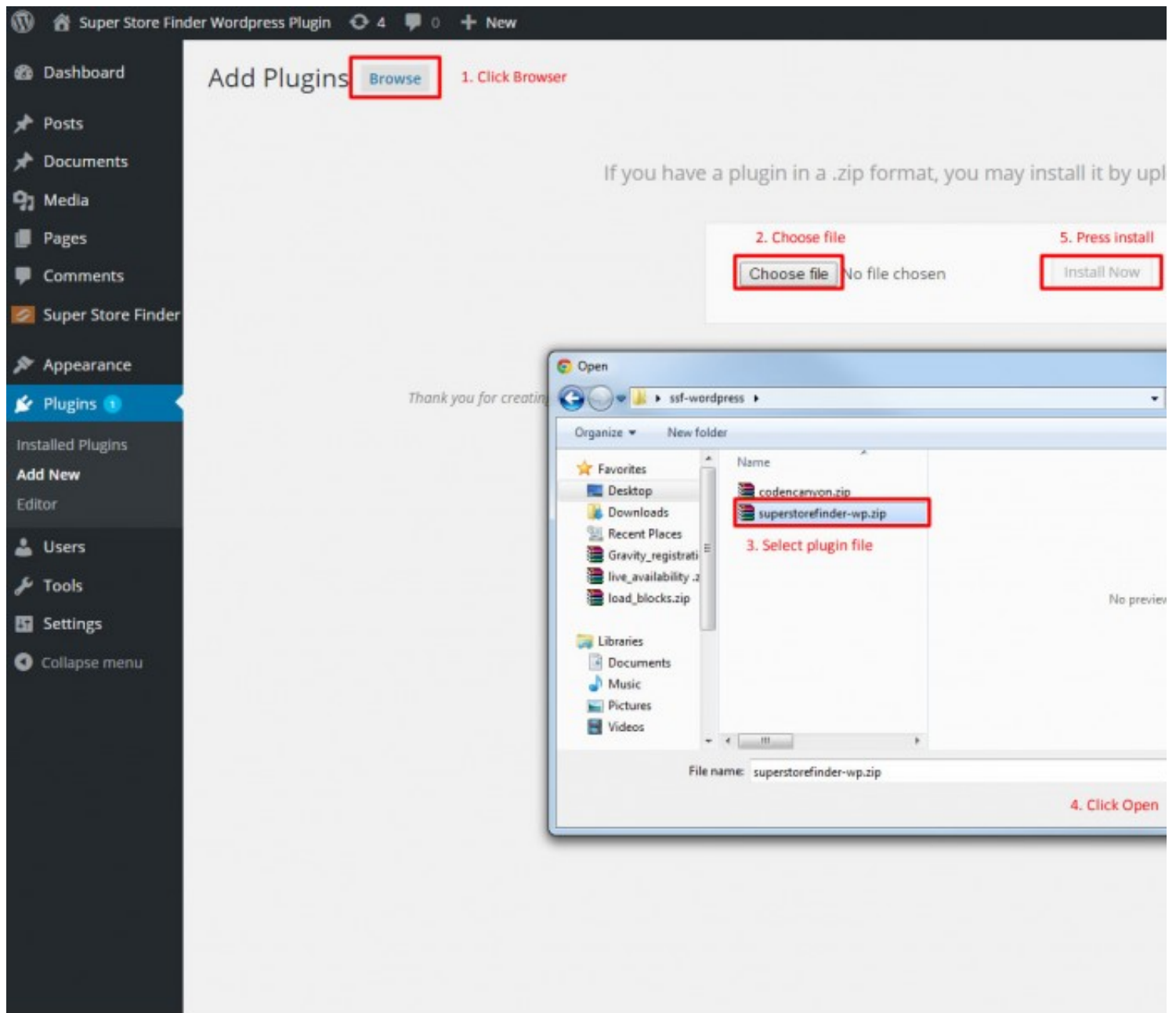

Firstly, extract (Unzip) the plugin download package. Within the download package you'll find the following file structure and contents:

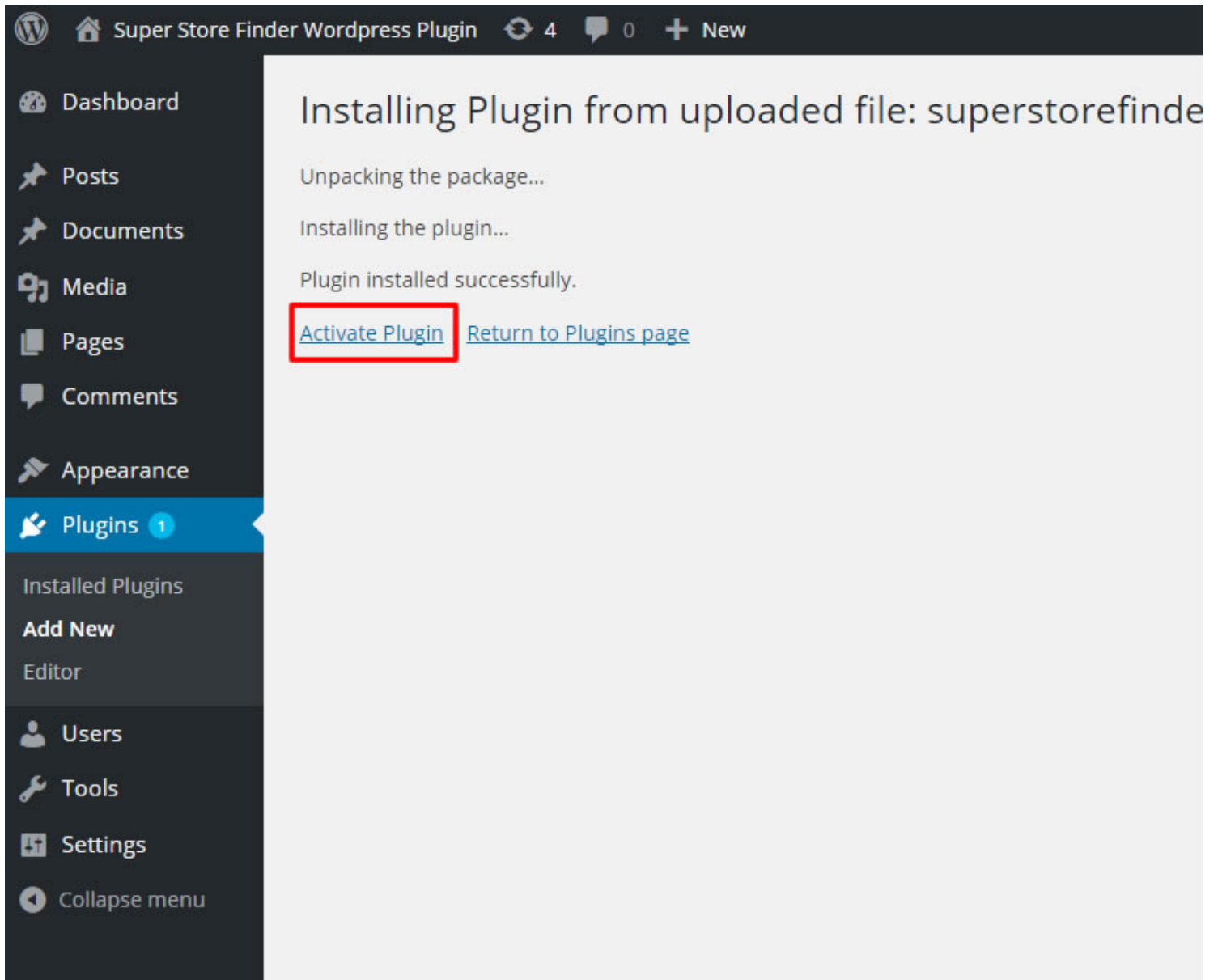
superstorefinder-wp.zip



1. Go to **Plugins > Add New**
2. Under Upload, click **Browse**, locate **superstorefinder-wp.zip** in your plugin download package and click Open.
3. Find the WordPress Plugin you wish to install.
4. Click **Install Now** to install the WordPress Plugin.



5. A popup window will ask you to confirm your wish to install the Plugin.
6. If this is the first time you've installed a WordPress Plugin, you may need to enter the FTP login credential information. If you've installed a Plugin before, it will still have the login information. This information is available through your web server host.
7. Click Proceed to continue with the installation. The resulting installation screen will list the installation as successful or note any problems during the install.
8. If successful, click **Activate Plugin** to activate it.

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3.2 USING SHORTCODES



4.1 IMPORT/EXPORT STORES

1. To import Stores, you can first click on Download Sample CSV and you can input your own list of addresses.
2. Click Import and Geo Code to proceed to import
3. Click on Export Stores to export the stores to a CSV file.

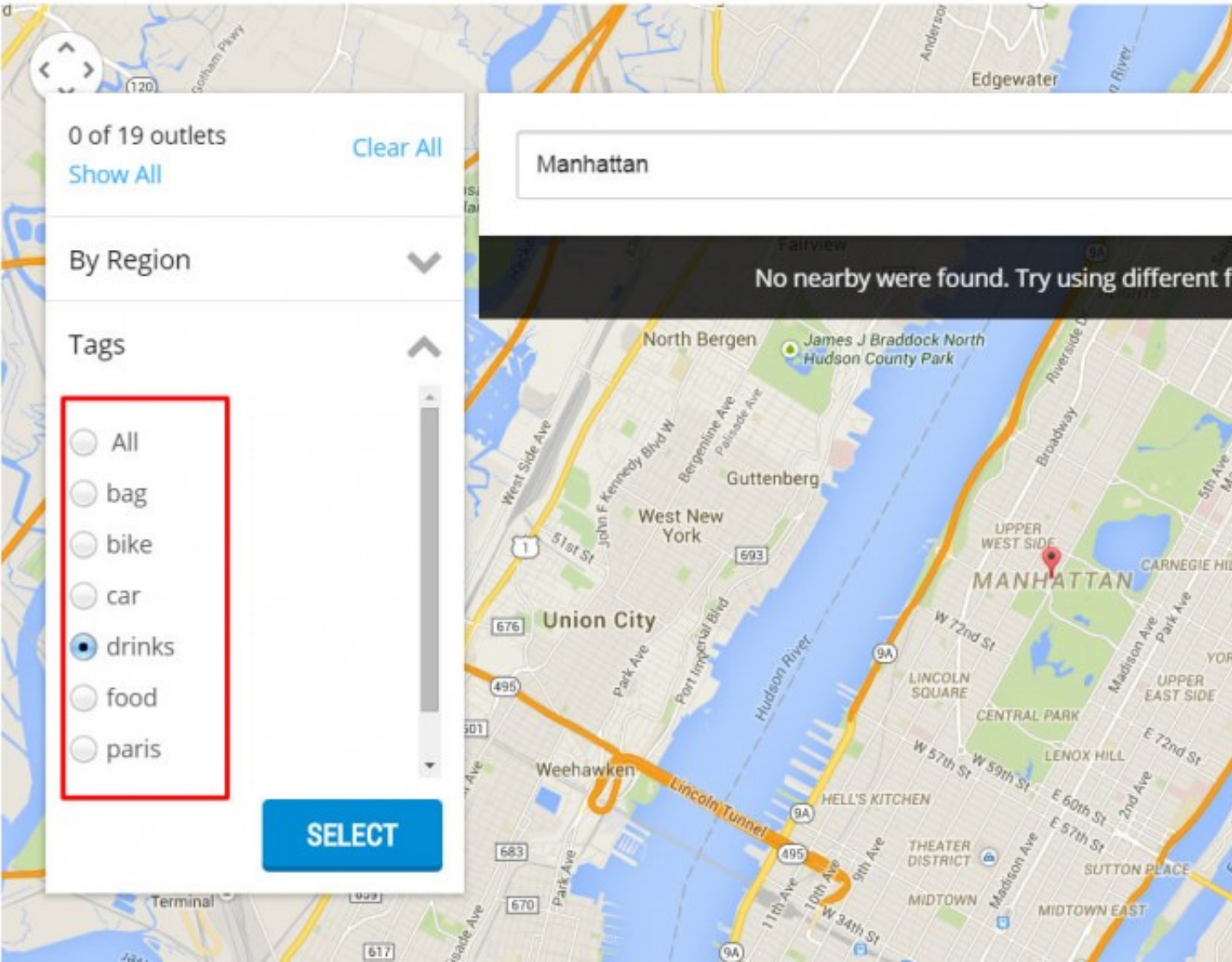

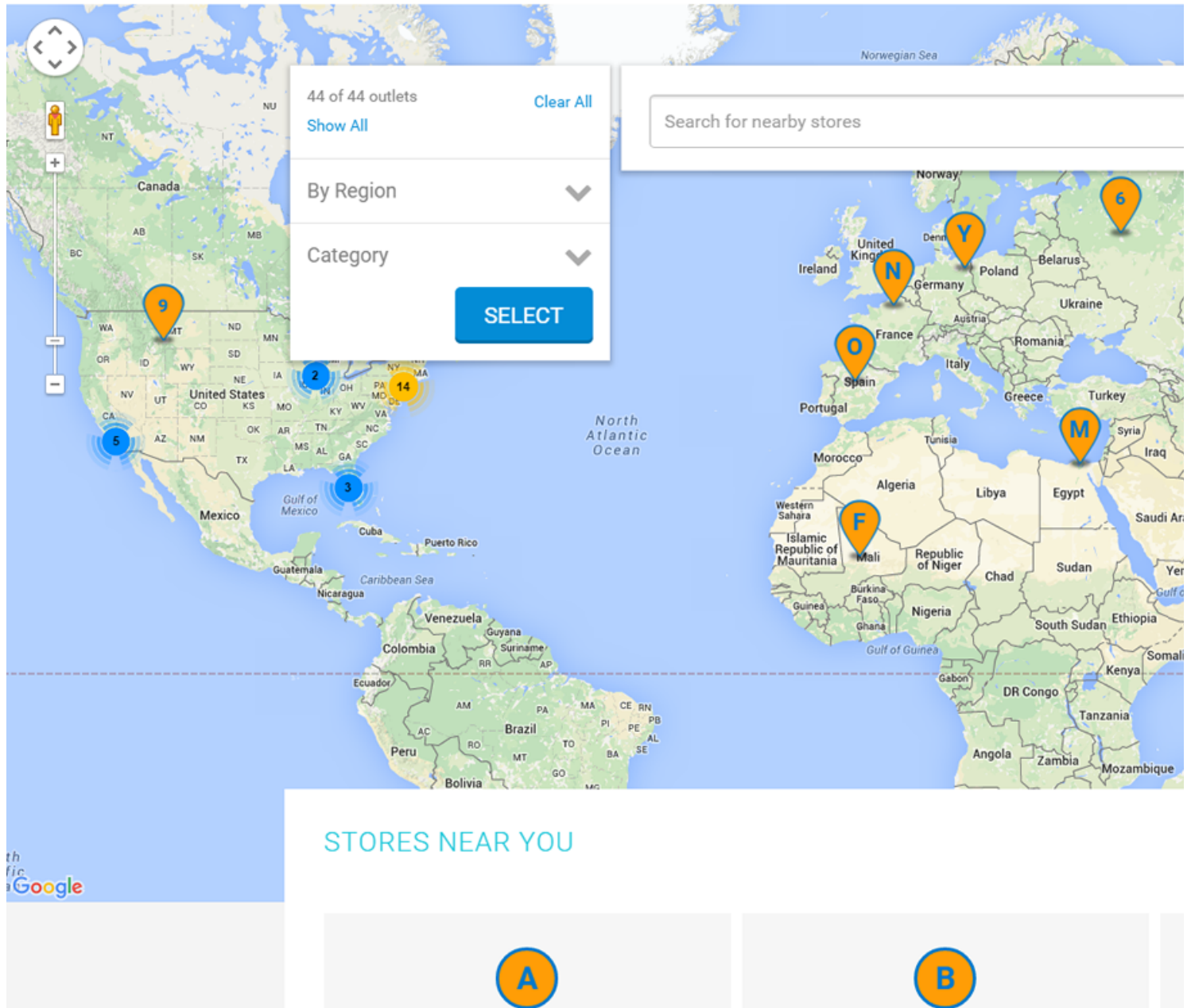
